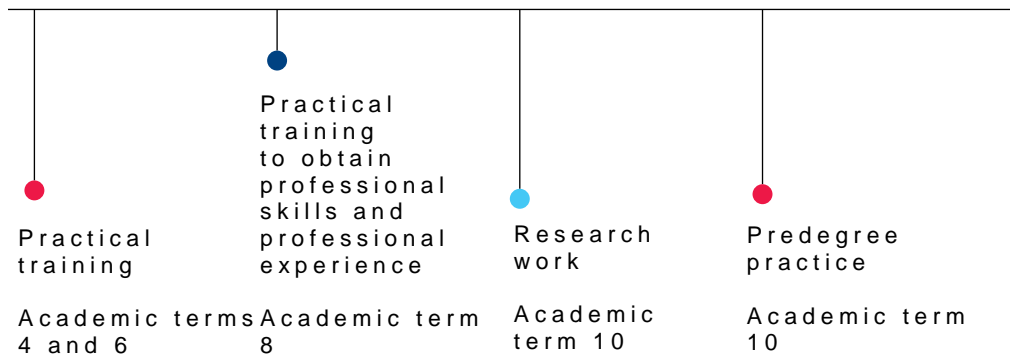


# Job trainings
